Commenced with Strong breezes but Made sail Single topical  
and at 4 Pm More made ditto & Set the gale winds S.S.E.  
and brook out for a bit of heave & C. & middle parts high  
winds & all sail set at 50 fms More ditto weather & Sound  
these 24 hours & in latt by Chh 43. 53. South and  
Long in 61. 20. West & C.

February the 25 Day these 24 hours Commenced with  
light winds from the S. S. E. & C. at 4 Pm Calms  
at 5 Pm breeze from the north & a. Sail insight & middle  
parts Strong breezes at 5 Am Saw a right whale & homed  
a way but Did not get the whale at 7. Saw 2 more and  
that was our share & the winds N. N. W. & C.  
at 10 Am 1 whale & homed a way but Did not get  
the whale & Sound these 24 hours & in latt by Chh  
46. 59. South & Long in 61. 25. West 


February the 26 Day these 24 hours Commenced with  
pleasant weather wind S. S. E. & C. South Green  
water at 4 Pm Sounded 8. 65 fathoms & C. at 4 Pm  
Saw a plenty of hiders & the Carcks of a Whale & pleasant  
then & C. at 7 Pm lookin in all sail & the middle parts  
Strong breezes at 7 Am a Strong Gale of wind from  
S. S. W. & C. 60 fathoms of the water & C. and  
the parts a. Strong Gale & Sound these 24 hours  
S. S. W. 60 South & in Long 61. 50. West

February the 27 Day these 24 hours Commenced with Gale  
wind at 6 Pm were Ship & a Gale of wind & a Gale of wind  
from the S. S. W. at 7 Pm a Strong Gale & a heavy  
Swell on & C. and latter parts of these 24 hours a Strong  
Gale of wind from the S. S. W. & in latt by  
Chh 46. 30 South and in Long 61. 30 West & C.

February the 28 Day these 24 hours Commenced with  
Strong gale of wind & a heavy Swell & C. at 8 Pm More made  
parts thick Cloudy weather at 9 Am Made sail and  
parts light winds & fresh breeze insight and Sound these 24 hours  
& in latt by Chh 46. 30 South and in Long 61. 30 West & C.

March the 1 Day 1829 these 24 hours  
Commenced with light wind & all sail set & the water  
employed in Ship's Duty & C. at 7 Pm took in all sail &  
the winds light and middle parts light winds at 7 Am  
all hands Cautioned & washed up Decks & thick fog & light  
winds & Stearing w. S. W. and Sound these 24 hours with  
thick fog & in latt South 46. 27. & in Long 61. 00. West

March the 2 Day these 24 hours Commenced with Strong breeze  
and a Sail in Sight & C. at 3 Pm Saw 2 whales & homed  
but did not get parts at 4 Pm Spoke the ship Adams  
New York Capt. Gardner 2 whales & C. at 7 lookin all  
all sail middle parts Strong breezes at 6 Am fog at  
8 Am made sail at 9 Pm Saw 3 whales & latter parts  
Saw another whale & homed a way but did not get parts  
& Saw a <sup>strange</sup> Sail & Sound these 24 hours & in latt  
46. 36. South and in Long 59. 50. West & C.

March the 3 Day these 24 hours Commenced with light  
winds from the west & Stearing E. S. E. & C. at 4 Pm  
Rose whales & homed and the waste boat got the whale  
& got him a long Sic at 7 Pm & at 9 Pm Spoke the  
Ship George parton of New Bedford Capt Sampson's  
waste went on board & middle parts Strong breezes at 5 Am  
Commenced cutting in the whale & finished at 11 Pm  
& Sound these 24 hours & in latt South 46. 36. &  
& in Long 59. 34 West & C. 

March the 4 Day these 24 hours Commenced with Strong  
breeze from the South & all hands employed in putting  
at 4 Pm took in all sail & Stearing w. at 6 Pm Set  
the watches & C. and middle parts Calms at 6 Am a light breeze  
at 8 Am made all sail & a Sail insight at 8 Am the whale  
employed in cutting C. & light winds and Sound these 24 hours  
& a light breeze & in latt by Chh 46. 31 South and in  
Long 59. 47 West & C.
