

Remarks on Board Ship Herald

Thursday Nov 11. 1847.

At 9 AM got under way
with a fresh breeze from SW by W
and steamed out of the bay in
company with ship Logans at
11 discharged the pilot

Friday Nov 12

Latitude 39° 51'
Longitude 68° 56'

Commenced with a fresh
breeze from SW by W with cloudy
weather at 1 PM lost sight
of the land all hands employed
in lashing the anchors and
stowing away the cables at 5
PM double reefed the main
top sail and chose watches at 7
PM hoisted the gaff and main sail
latter part fine weather made
all sail all hands employed
in fitting the boats

Saturday Nov 13

Latitude 39° 44'
Longitude 67° 16'

First part of this day a light
breeze from SW by W steady & light
with all sail set middle part
hoisted the topgallant sails
latter part thick and
rainy with the wind
from the northward the
watch employed in fitting
the boats
