

Remarks on Board Friday November 11th 1831
Commenced with moderate breeze from the S.W. part
and fair weather at 3 P.M. saw one Whale bound eastward
Middle part fine weather
Latter part fine weather at 5 P.M. saw two Whales
lashed two boats struck and killed one of them
at 10 took him along side at 11 commenced
L.S. 2 miles Lat 11° 38' 32.50 South

Remarks on Board Saturday November 12th
Commenced with fine pleasant weather employed
sailing at 3 P.M. finished at 4 saw two Whales
bound and struck them killed one at 6
took her along side
Middle part fine weather latter part fair gale
from the South employed Stowing Down till
5 saw a Bonny Ship to the seaward so ran this Day
Lat 11° 38' 32.14 South

Remarks on Board Sunday November 13th
Commenced with fresh gale from the South
and squally at 2 P.M. commenced sailing
at 4 P.M. the fluke of some boats at half past four
got the Commencement at 7 finished sailing
Middle part strong breeze and clear weather
latter part moderate breeze at 6 P.M. saw a Ship to the
windward 3 miles Lat 11° 38' 32.00 South

Remarks on Board Monday November 14th
Commenced with strong breeze from the South
employed sailing and Stowing Down till
Middle part fair weather
Latter part with the same employed
sailing one Ship in sight 3 miles
Lat 11° 38' 32.05 South

Remarks on Board Tuesday November 15th
Commenced with moderate breeze from the South
and fair weather at 3 P.M. finished sailing at 5 saw two
Whales bound and struck one of at 7 cut from him
Middle part fine weather
Latter part with the same at 7 P.M. saw one Whale
struck and killed her at 10 took her along side
at 11 commenced sailing to end Lat 11° 38' 32.14 South

Remarks on Board Wednesday November 16th
Commenced with light breeze and fair weather
at 4 P.M. saw one Whale struck and killed her at 5 finished
sailing at 6 took the whale along side
Middle part fine weather
Latter part strong breeze and foggy
at 8 P.M. commenced sailing at 10 got the head of
and part of her in sight commenced sailing
and Stowing Down to end Lat 11° 38' 31.11 South

Remarks on Board Thursday November 17th
Commenced with fresh breeze and fair weather
at 1 P.M. began to cut again at 4 finished
Middle part fine weather
Latter part with the same employed sailing
and making out for Cape to end this Day
Lat 11° 38' 31.54 South long by Chronometer 71° 40' East

Remarks on Board Friday November 18th
Commenced with light breeze and pleasant
weather sailing
Middle part with the same
Latter part light wind from the South heading to
the eastward and light breeze Stowing Down
and Repairing the Landward Boat saw two Ships
sailing to end Lat 11° 38' 32.03 South

Remarks on Board Saturday November 19th
Commenced with moderate breeze from the South
and fair weather employed sailing and Stowing
Down Middle part clear weather
Latter part light wind from the S.W. to S.E. part
and foggy employed Stowing Down till
5 P.M. this Day Lat 11° 38' 32.04 South
