Saturday

September the 7 all this day strong breezes from the North steering West by North

At 6 P.M. saw three grampuse the first Spouting fish we have seen since we have been out And so ends this Day

September the 8 first part of this day squally and strong wind from the North heading to the West North West middle part squally with rain heading the same latter part strong breeze and pleasant the wind North North East heading North West so ends this day

Monday September the 9 first part of this day light wind from the North East and pleasant heading East South East a sail in sight to the south middle and latter part calm or nearly so and pleasant the wind West South West heading South lored the boats to practice and then came on board and took a smoke and turned in and so ends this Day

Tuesday September the 10 first part of this day light breeze from the West South West heading South At 5 A.M. took ship to the North East At 6 P.M. wore ship ~~with~~ and stood to the south employed Braking out for provision so ends this day

Wednesday September the 11 first and middle parts of this Day squally and rough with rain latter part fine weather the wind North steering East by North employed fitting the mizen rizen a sail in sight so ends this day

Thursday September the 12 first part of this day fine weather And light wind from the westward steering North East by East Middle part calm latter part moderate breezes from the West steering South East by East employed sending down the mizen top mast and fitting the rizen so ends this Day

Friday September the 13 all of this day fine weather and light Breezes from the West first part steering South East middle part steering East North East latter part steering East employed fitting the mizen rizen two sails in sight caught a porpoise And had his liver and brains for supper so ends this day

Saturday September the 14 all of this day fine weather and Light breeze from the westward steering East a sail in sight employed rat lin down the mizen rizen so ends this day

Sunday September the 15 first part of this day pleasant weather and light light rain squally middle and latter part pleasant wind from the West south West steering East by South so ends this day

Monday September the 16 all of this ^{day} fine pleasant weather and light breeze from the South West steering East At half past 4 saw Whales and lowered the boats and the Starboard boat struck one and gut stove all into a smash at half past 7 took him a long side and then gut supper and set the watch and took a good smoke and gut ready for cutting and so ends this Day
