Thursday, Aug 28th

first and middle strong breeze
later moderate breeze from the S.W. with rain
and fog saw two sails one of the was the
A Beaufort

Friday Aug 29th

first fresh breeze from the N. later
moderate breeze from W. to S.W. vessel by the wind
on different tacks Sounded on the Georges Banks
in 40 and 35 Fathoms of water saw several Steamers
and several sailing vessels on the Hamlet this is
the first pleasant Day that we have had since
we left Hudsons Bay

Sat 40 25 N Long 68 50 W
Saturday Aug 30th

commences with fresh breeze from
the S.W. middle wind N.W. at 10 A.M. passed
Nantuxet South Shoal light Boat with
light airs from N. to S.W. at sundown Norman
Land Baring N. distance 6 miles several Chouers
in site one of them a Whale got the Anchors
off the Booms and bent the chains 10 P.M.
took Pilot off Norman S. Land

Sunday Aug 31st

commences with light breeze from
the S.W. at 3 A.M. wind N.W. Anchored off
Clarks Point the first officer and Mr. Rankin
went on shore to ashore
