Thursday Aug 28th

first and middle Strong breeze
light moderate breeze from the S. & S.E. with rain
and fog saw two birds one of them was the
A. Bradford

Friday Aug 29th

first fresh breeze from the N. latter
moderate breeze from W. to S.W. caused by the wind
on different banks sounded on the Georges Banks
in 40. and 35. Fathoms of Water saw several steamers
and several sailing vessels on Sherman this is
the first pleasant Day that we have had since
we left Hudson's Bay

Lat 40° 25' N Long 68° 30' 18"

Saturday Aug 30th

commences with fresh breeze from
the S.W. middle wind N.W. at 10. A.m. passed
Nantucket South Shoal light Boat latter
light airs from N. to S.W. at sundown No man
Land Bearing N. distance 6 miles several whalers
in site one of them a Whaler got the Anchors
off the bows and bent the chains to P.M.
Took Pilot off Norman's Land

Sunday Aug 31th

commences with light breeze from
the S.W. at 3. A.M. wind N.W. increased off
Clarks Point the first officer and Mr. Randt
went on shore to anchor
