

Remarks on board of the James

May Sunday 10th
Bark James Anchoring sails this day from the Port Honolulu S.S. under the command of Capt Bartlett Bound Home At 12 M the Pilot left at 2 P.M. the Capt came on board Bowed anchors braced forward heading S E with a strong breeze at 3 P.M. double reefed Top sails at 5 P.M. chose the watches so ends this day

Monday 11th
This day strong breeze from the N E steering S S E. Making and taking in sail unbent cables so ends the day

Tuesday 12th
This day fore part strong breezes took in top gallant sails latter part lighter breezes all hands employed in pumping ship with 3 feet of water in hold at 5 P.M. freed her so ends the day

Wednesday 13th
the fore part top gallant sail breezes ship makes some water. the crew employed about ships duty latter part more moderate wind to N E ship heading S E. pumped ship at 6 P.M. with 18 feet water in hold nothing in sight so ends the day

May Thursday 14th
The fore part fresh breezes from the N E ship heading S E the latter part moderate nothing in sight so ends the day

Friday 15th
This day commenced with strong breezes from the N E latter part moderate all hands employed about ships duty nothing in sight so ends this day

Saturday 16th
the fore part of this day moderate winds from the N E ship heading S E the latter part light winds from the N nothing in sight so ends the day

Sunday 17th
the fore part of this day light winds from the N ship heading to the south the crew employed in setting hole the latter part light breezes from the N nothing in sight so ends the day

Monday 18th
the fore part of this day light breeze from the N to the N at 6 M set strain top gallant shudding sail steering S S E the latter part winds light and changeable with the rigging forward nothing in sight so ends the day
