

Remarks on Board Ship  
June

Sunday 5<sup>th</sup>

This day light breeze from the N at 8<sup>h</sup> ship's keel weighed anchor of Clark's point and stood out to sea Pilot Joseph Peter left at 11<sup>h</sup> AM wind hauled to the S W at 6 PM. Chose watches stowed anchors and cleared decks quite a number of sails in sight

Monday 6<sup>th</sup>

All this day light winds from W steering S E by E S E. all hands on mast deck fitting Boats and about ship's duty. Boats remarkably Green one sail in sight but the flying jib over so ends the day

Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup>

This day light breeze from the N W steering S E by E. All hands on deck two sails in sight

Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup>

This day began with light breeze from the N W at 9 AM it hauled to the S E ship on the Star tack. All hands on deck 3 sails in sight and several schools of Black fish

Thursday 9<sup>th</sup>

All this day strong breeze from S W steering S E by E. under double reefed Japsails Watch below one sail in sight

Friday 10<sup>th</sup>

This day light winds from the N W Watch below one sail in sight at 6 PM. Lowered the boats and practiced the crew. Chose boats crews this day

Saturday 11<sup>th</sup>

The fore part light winds from the S W. Latter part strong breeze took in Japs gallant sails and flying jib broke out for water

Sunday 12<sup>th</sup>

The fore part of this day squally from all directions latter part wind strong from the N E steering S E at 6 PM ship's Hunter's passed to the windward of us distance one mile. Lightning and Thunder and rain

Monday 13<sup>th</sup>

This day fine breeze from the N E steering S E by E. broke out Japs sails in sight and one school of Black fish

Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup>

This day light breeze from the N E ship on the Star tack fine weather one sail in sight at 6 PM lowered the Boats and practiced pulling

Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup>

All this day mostly calm and very hot at 6 PM lowered and practiced pulling

Thursday 16<sup>th</sup>

All this day light breeze indeed from the S E ship on the Star tack set up the jib guys and stays and Japs gallant back stays one sail in sight two men fiddle taken duty

Friday 17<sup>th</sup>

This day light winds from the S E ship by the wind one sail in sight
