

Remark on board the Bark Ocean Steed in the North

Sunday July the 17th 1870
This day commenced with moderate gale from S.W. the ship heading S.P. W. saw porpoises at sunset the weather a bit the same middle part rain & thick cloudy latter part pleasant weather saw rather so ends this day
Lat 40. 29 N Long

Monday July the 18th
This day commenced with very light airs & calm at one pm saw Blackfish still calm at sunset took in the light sails the weather still the same middle & latter part rain saw one sail the ships steering, S.E. so ends this day Lat 40. 36 N Long 46. 44 W

Tuesday July the 19th
All this 24 hours light breezes & rain & thick cloudy saw one sail & porpoises brought out weather so ends this day Lat 40. 35 N Long 46. 54 W

Wednesday July the 20th
This day commenced with very light winds & rain saw one sail at sunset took in the up top sails

Monday
August the First
At this 24 hours fine pleasant weather saw rather

Tuesday
August the 2nd 1870
This day commenced with calm at sunset took in the light sails middle & latter part the same saw porpoises

Wednesday
August the 3rd 1870
All this 24 hours calm one sail in sight still in played on ship duly so ends this day

Thursday
August the 4th 1870
This day commenced with calm at sunset three sail in sight middle part still calm at day light sail in sight at daylight light breeze from W ship heading S. by W so ends this day

Friday
August the 5th 1870
This day commenced with light breeze from W ship heading S. by W 2 sails in sight at sunset took in light sails middle part cloudy at daylight rain squally saw 2 miles land to the E so ends this day Lat 38. 59 N Long 44. 11 W

Saturday
August the 6th 1870
This day commenced with very fine wind from S.W. ship heading S.P. W one sail in sight middle & latter part fresh breeze & rain squally saw 2 miles Lat 38. 15 N Long
