

Remarks on board Ship James Edwards

November ^{15th} ~~September~~ 1855
at 9 P.M. got the ship
under way with light air
from the S at calm and
so ends

Friday November 16th
These 24 hours come in with
light breezes from the E & S
Tiding to Tuck at 4 A.M. the wind
blew up from SW and steered
out of the bay at 10 P.M. discharged
the the pilot and ked 58 by 5
mudd and later part with
breezes too sail in night steering S

Saturday November 17th
First part of these 24 hours
strong breezes from S & S
steering S by E employed
stowing the bales and in
putting tops in these places
too which ships in sight
steering S by E at
5 A.M. put the reef in
the topsails at 11 the wind hauled
to the NW later part more
moderate and sail and so ends
Latitude 38° 02' Longitude 120° 08'

Sunday November 18th
First part of these 24 hours commenced
with fresh breeze from the E steering
S & S mid part shifted to the SW
tacked ship and ked to S &
at 4 A.M. double reefed the topsails
later part the wind hauled to
latitude 37° 15' the W with squally weather
