

1868 Bark James Murray Log Book

Thurs Aug 27th

Begins with fresh Windy from N^W and pleasant Ship Longly Ancher off Clarke Point at 2⁰⁰ AM receive on Board the Pilot and took the Ancher Ship steering out of the Bay under all Sail at 11⁰⁰ AM discharged the Pilot and stowed the Anchors & Chains

Lat 41⁰⁰ 15⁰⁰ N

Fry Aug 28th

Begins the same Ship steering S under all prudent Sail all hands employed in rigging the Boats at 3⁰⁰ PM Double Reefed the Top Sails Middle part Wind hauling to Eastward Latter part pleasant stowed the Reefs from the Top Sails and set Top Gallant Sails

Lat 39⁰⁰ 08⁰⁰ N

Long 70⁰⁰ 08⁰⁰ W

Sat Aug 29th

Begins the same Ship steering by the Wind to the Southward under all Sail all hands employed working on the Boats Middle part Wind and weather the same Latter part the same Watch employed in Ships Duties

Lat 38⁰⁰ 40⁰⁰ N

Long 69⁰⁰ 15⁰⁰ W

Sund Aug 30th

Begins with light Breeze from the Northward Ship steering S & Q under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part Rain Squalls Ship steering Q with a light Breeze from W

Lat 38⁰⁰ 22⁰⁰ N

Long 68⁰⁰ 40⁰⁰ W
