

Bargee Jasper Near the Cape

Thursday Oct 29<sup>th</sup> Commences with  
light winds and pleasant at 6 PM  
saw the Island of St. Jago Dist 20  
at 11 saw the Island of Mayo Bearing  
E S E Dist 13 miles at 4 backed the  
main yard and sent the Boat on shore  
and carried a Barrel of Sp Oil to trade  
but the commandant would not let us  
trade we came on Board steering for  
the town this Ends

Friday Oct 30<sup>th</sup> Commences with  
light winds at 5 AM came aboard off  
St. Jago and the capt came aboard  
there and got a Spar for a top mast  
this Ends lying off an on  
No obs this Day

Saturday Oct 31<sup>st</sup> Commences with light  
winds from the N E lying off an on at  
St. Jago the Capt on shore trading  
at 11 AM the Capt came on Board  
with 2200 oranges & hogs & Bunchy Bananas  
50 coconuts & fresh took up the Boat kept  
her off S S W lying at St. Jago store  
Ship Southampton and W S A Frigate  
United Sataty of 60 guns sent our Letter  
home by the Store Ship this Ends

Sunday Oct Nov 1<sup>st</sup> Commences with  
brisk breeze from N E steering S S E all  
night middle and latter part the same  
Latt 1240 Long 2246

Monday Nov 2<sup>nd</sup> Commences with light  
winds and pleasant Middle and latter  
part the same this Ends with Tempest  
W. E. Steering S S E No observation

Tuesday Nov 3<sup>rd</sup> Commences with squally  
wind and rain with thunder and lightning  
employed at breaking out the M & after  
W. E. latter part stowed down  
wind squally this Ends steering S S E  
Latt 940 Long 2330

Wednesday Nov 4<sup>th</sup> Commences with squally  
rainy saw 3 sails all sail out  
steering S S E this Ends 4 sails in  
sight saw porpoises and fin back  
Latt 800 Long 2315

Thursday Nov 5<sup>th</sup> Commences with strong  
breeze from E steering S S E all sail out  
Middle part the same latter part  
squally Latt 712 Long 2320

Friday Nov 6<sup>th</sup> Commences with strong  
squally from all quarters accompanied  
with tremendous thunder and  
lightning saw Blackfish lowered  
all 3 boats but with out success  
this Ends Latt 650 Long 2220

Saturday Nov 7<sup>th</sup> Commences with  
heavy squally of rain and thunder  
Middle and latter part the same  
this Ends Latt 840 Long 2145
