Tuesday October the 10th
Commences light winds and
calms from S.E. Steering N.W.
under all sail, Middle and
Latter parts fine weather
Lat. by Obs. 28.47 N.
Long. by act. 59.40 W.

Wednesday October the 11th
Commences fresh winds from N.E.
with squalls steering N.W. by N.
under all sail, Middle and Latter
parts, fresh winds from East to
S.E. passed a Brig and Barge thick
rainy weather
Lat. by Obs. 30.05 N.

Thursday October the 12th
Commences fresh winds and rain
from S.E. steering N.W. by N. under
all sail, Middle part much the
same, Latter part light winds
N.W. heading N.W. under all sail
Lat. by Obs. 31.53 N.
Long. by act. 62.32 W.

Friday October the 13th
Commences light winds and calms
from N.W. heading N.W. under
all sail, Middle and Latter parts
light winds and calms from
every point in the compass
Lat. by Obs. 31.14 N.
Long. by act. 64.50 W.

from St Helena to Boston

Saturday October the 14th
Commences with calms and a heavy
breeze from the south
Middle and Latter parts light
winds and calms from N.W. to
East.
Lat. by Obs. 31.57 N.
Long. by act. 62.38 W.
Long. by Eclips 62.40 W.

Sunday October the 15th
Commences fresh breezes N.E. by E.
steering N.W. by N. under all sail
at 4 P.M. saw a Brig which showed
Russian colours, steering to the south
Middle and Latter parts fresh winds
from E.S.E. steering from N.W. to N.W.
under single reefs with a very bad
sea on
Lat. by Obs. 31.33 N.
Long. by Obs. 65.10 W.

Monday October the 16th
Commences fresh gales and clear weather
with a very bad sea running from
the Eastward and Brig in sight heading
to the northward, at 1 P.M. set whole
fore and Main Tapsails, steering
N.W. with a bad sea
Middle and Latter parts, more
moderately steering N.W. under
all sail,
Lat. by Obs. 36.44 N.
Long. by act. 66.20 W.
