Remarks on Board Thursday June 10<sup>th</sup> 1830

at Meridian weighed anchor and came out of the river at 3 came through the hole at 3 P.M. anchored in the bite. Latter part strong breezes and rainy still lying at anchor. So Ends.

Remarks on Board Friday 11<sup>th</sup> 1830

first part strong breezes and thick weather Middle and latter part pleasant wind from the Westward at 3 P.M. weighed anchor and stood out of the sound at Meridian Gay Head bore by Compass S.E. by S. Dist 14 miles from which I take my departure. Gay Head in the Lat of N 21<sup>st</sup> and Long of 70-50 West

Remarks on Board Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> 1830

first and middle part Pleasant breezes and fine weather wind from S.W. Steering South latter part Calm So laid one sail in night. to the Southward. Lat by Alt 39-52. Long by Alt 72-10 West

Remarks on Board Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> 1830

first part light air and calm ~~and~~ variable from South to West. Middle part pleasant breezes from the Westward. Latter part light and calm with some rain. So laid. Steering South under all sail. Lat by Alt 38-41 Long by Alt 71-52 West

Remarks on Board Monday 14<sup>th</sup> 1830

Strong breezes and rainy these twenty four hours wind from S.W. Steering South under short sail. So Ends. Lat by Alt 37-24 S. Long by Alt 71-40 West

Remarks on Board Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> 1830

Squally and rainy all these twenty four hours wind variable from South to S.W. Steering East under all sail. So Ends. Lat by Alt 37-29 S Long by Alt 70-00 West

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
