Log Book of Bark Tara of New Bedford

1864

Friday Aug 26th

Begins with a fresh breeze from SW with
thick weather ship at anchor at 3 P.M.
all hands on board took anchor and
commenced working out at 4 P.M. came to
anchor in 10 fathoms of water and thick
fog at 3 A.M. took anchor and worked
out at 10 A.M. the pilot left ship heading
S with pleasant weather all sail set at
10 morning land bearing E dist 15 miles

Lat 39 deg 41 35 N
Long 69 deg 56 11 W

1864

Saturday Aug 27th

First part moderate from SW by S with pleasant
weather ship steering S by E middle and last
part backing ship by the wind with all
sail set quite pleasant weather the hands
employed pitting boats and other jobs
about ship saw several sails heading
different ways so ends this day

Lat obs 40-15 N
Long do 69-11 W

Sunday Aug 28th

Overcast this day moderate from various
points ship head to the eastward under
all prudent sail several sails in sight
heading different ways so ends this day
the hands employed pitting boats and
other jobs about the ship

Lat obs 39-57 N
Long do 67-24 W
