1864

Saturday Sept 10th
First part a fresh breeze from S.W. with pleasant weather last part more moderate steering E.S.E. all sail set saw nothing the hands employed

Lat obs 39.36 N
Long do 35.50 W

Sunday Sept 11th
Throughout this day a moderate breeze from S.W. with pleasant weather and a heavy swell from W.N.W. ship steering by compass E.S.E. with all sail set

Lat obs 39.34 N
Long by chr 33.30 W

Monday Sept 12th
Throughout this light airs from W.S.W. with calms and pleasant weather employed at various jobs about ship saw nothing so ends this day

Lat obs 39.40 N
Long by chr 32.43 W

Tuesday Sept 13th
Throughout this day moderate and pleasant from S.W. to W.N.W. steering by compass E.S.E. with all sail set at 6 A.M. saw the Island of Belones bearing E.S.E. dist 40 miles saw a ship to the South by ends this day the hands employed at various jobs

Lat obs 39.33 N
Long by chr 31.33 W

Wednesday Sept 14th
Moderate breeze from W.N.W. with pleasant weather steering for Belones middle part by 10 at 7 A.M. the boat went on shore the Bark Pioneer in company saw a ship steering E.S.E. a Bark to the W. so ends this day at Belones

Thursday Sept 15th
This day commences with pleasant weather from W.N.W. ship off & on at Belones at 6 P.M. the boat came on board stowed 90 middle & last part a fresh breeze ship with prudent sail set at 11.30. saw a Bark bearing E.S.E. dist 25 miles so ends this day hands employed
