

Tuesday Nov 2^d Commenced with a calm employed in various ways about the ship and fitting boats at half past 4 p.m. the Bark Keoka came on board and returned again after tea Middle part much the same Latter part employed fitting boats

Friday Nov 4th Light wind and pleasant weather steering S. E. by E. employed in various ways about the Bark Keoka at sunset the wind S. W. heading S. E. with all sail out - Middle part strong breeze heading E. took in the fore top gullant sail - Latter part more moderate but the fore top gullant sail again and fine pleasant weather, all hands employed in various ways about the ship. Lat 31° 18' N.

Saturday Nov 5th Light wind and fine pleasant weather steering S. E. by E. - Middle part the wind increased to a Gale and we took in all sail but the main reefed main top sail and fore top mast stay sail and steered S. E. Latter part much the same steering S. E. by E. no observation

Sunday Nov 6th Commenced with a Gale from the N. E. and a very heavy sea steering S. E. by E. - Middle part much the same Latter part very rainy Lat 31° 12' N.

Monday Nov 7th Commenced with a Gale from the N. E. and very rugged the ship lying too under a close reefed main top sail and mizen and fore top mast stay sail heading S. E. at sunset it moderated and we set the close reefed fore top sail and steered S. E. Middle part the wind very light and very rainy steering S. E. by E. Latter part a strong breeze set the fore sail and steered S. E.

Tuesday Nov 8th Commenced with a moderate Gale from N. E. and a rugged sea steering S. E. under close reefed top sails and fore sail - Middle part the wind increased to a perfect Gale took in the fore top sail and fore sail and bore the ship too heading S. by E. Latter part the same Lat 31° 00' N. Long 57° 12' W.

Wednesday Nov 9th Commenced with a moderate Gale the ship heading S. E. at 2 p.m. set the close reefed fore top sail - Middle part more moderate and set the fore sail - Latter part much the same Lat 31° 00' N. Long 57° 04' W.

Thursday Nov 10th Commenced with a moderate Gale from S. E. the ship heading S. S. E. Middle part bore ship heading S. E. and very rainy - Latter pleasant weather set the main sail Lat 31° 01' N. Long 57° 00' W.

Friday Nov 11th Commenced with a moderate breeze and pleasant weather heading S. employed in various ways - Middle part much the same heading S. E. Latter part traded ship heading S. Lat 31° 11' N.

Saturday Nov 12th Commenced with a light breeze and fine pleasant weather heading S. all hands employed in various ways after supper locked ship heading S. E. Middle part very squally and rainy - Latter part at 2 a.m. wore ship heading S. E. by E. at 4 a.m. bore ship again heading S. E. Lat 31° 23' N. Long 58° 12' W.

Sunday Nov 13th Light wind and squally heading S. E. employed in the hold - Middle part squally - Latter part pleasant weather - Lat 32° 48' N. Long 57° 49' W.
