Remarks on Board Ship Julia Hubbard
making passage

Dec 4 This day painted Boats, Mast and Boop, as well as the Deck, much in the same manner as for me, & rather see them look rather dull looking as though they meant to have them scraped a little see nothing but - Five Backs some of our hands are getting rather better and other work the Wash, bedig rather short-handed now though there is prospect of some of them getting around in a few days and winds the Cook being ill a heavy swell from the West and fine weather now but no wind broke out for sheet and ~~down~~ had some Thunder and rain took in light sails cleared up broke out for water did not see any Feb-16-00

Dec 4 The Wash to work mending sail and making Line Cores dead calms Chief heading W by N a pleasant evening that nothing to disturb the mind but the flapping of sails which sound good to my ear on such a night as this more Thunder but see rain plenty of heat lightning had a good breeze spring up made light sail on her square in the yards crashed at deck about 15.00 steering W by N

Dec 4 The Wash mending sail fore aft mast stay sail bent at night and some rain had a little the Cook taken sick and a few more
