course SW heads at most of the time back in Plover the Bell said
call that thick broke out for next Butter and Hums
also water set Plover by fall sail most of the Hums to work
on Boat sails we draw wheel of our Partner a little thick
leather most of the time

Monday July 30th

Rainy nothing done set BC Wishes the wind
increase still took in the fall sails Fly Sisk and Shanker
Steering the Wind C & O double the upper top sails no ship in
sight - Head of Star left course a ship to the windward of all
fall out shock ropes out of the sails boomed by fall sail and
Fly Jib - truffed on the wind head of the ship

Tuesday July 31st

Washed ship with much wind fell away to a dead
calm opening ship heading yards and so on all the back
wind shifting every 5 minutes stood half masts midship
a head wind heading N by W now wind C & O no, shall to
be seen or any light that there ever was any here then it
a ship in sight - fog no wind

Wednesday Aug 1st

Another month is began in the first of it became
on a stoven Boat and begin to repair her which during that
there was a thick rain of black close to some called a Ban Head
we covered the three Labour Boats for being out did not see him
again fog is quite thick no wind although they try to make a breeze

but all in vain hauled up Course and Shanker and Braced
round only six times in two hours not enough wind to make
a bump light - broke thick Fog Capt and Second Mate finished
the day with a little rain the
then ship plenty of small seals around Capt shot one a
light breeze appeared in hand set Braced fore and abeam to
Call that also Fly Jib course C & O wind from the S W

Thursday Aug 2nd Lat 55.55 N

The wind is very light rather heavy Capt shot another
seal gave them to the men to make Capt of both of them
have hair braced up had a little more wind and Fly took
in fore and abeam by fall sail also Fly Jib were close to the
wind head of the ship took thick fog and no wind.

Friday Aug 3rd Lat 54.50

Our Mate does not stand much more being unwell Fly closed
up a little he somewhat found 90 lbs of water saw hauled up Course
and check abeam fore ahead of main the fall sail Lanchin
sight to the windward of us a very light breeze headed forward
heading S W wind C & O shot little there is
