This day Begins with light Breeze from the S. E. and calm but part clearing
Break out the bar had still down with
flatter than one sail steering 1/2 E. (E. S. E.)

Sunday March the 19 1843

This day Begins with strong Breeze from the S. E. and rain speak Brig W
Hazy from the northward but at night
clear fine Breeze from the S. E.
steering 1/2 E. and 1/2 S. E. (E. S. E.)
Lat 24:35 Lon 70:45

Monday March the 20 1843

This day Begins with calm but part
strong Breeze from the N. E. heading
1/2 N. E. and 1/2 N. saw one sail heading
with tub and went further heavy swell
Lat 25:35 Lon 71:18

Tuesday March the 21 This day

Begins with strong Breeze from the
N. E. heading 1/2 N. E. and 1/2 N. but
heading N. S. E. calm saw one sail
at sunset right to sails 40 E. S. E.
Lat 26:26 Lon 70:58

Wednesday March the 22

This day Begins with calm but part
strong Breeze from the S. S. E. steering
N. E. and repaired the gibe nothing in
it so E. S. E. this day

in sail heading N. E. and but part
gale from the S. E. sailing true
under close reef mainmast
equally rain thunder heavy

reef mainmast heading N. E. but
part wind from the S. E. and 1/2 N. E.

took in sail 40 E. S. E.
