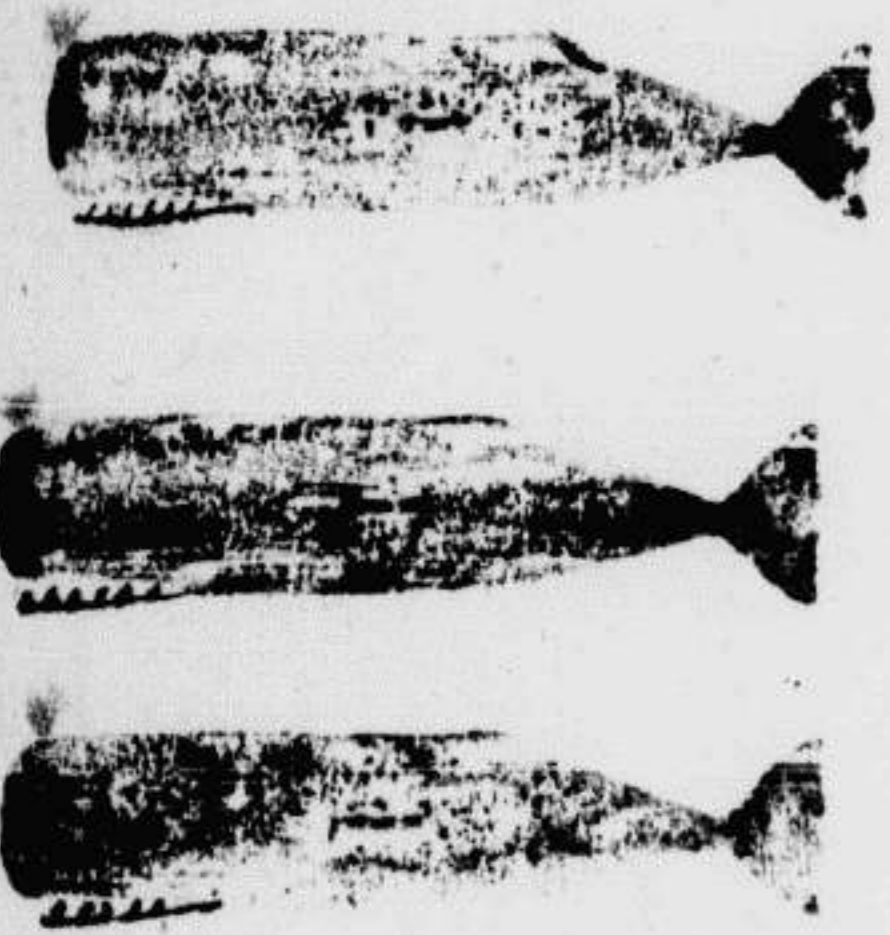


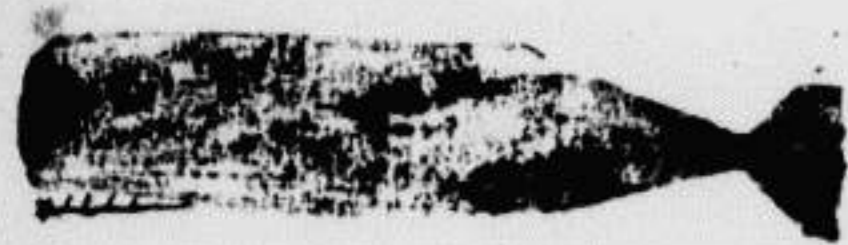
Whales caught on Board Brig Juno I Cook Master  
S Boat S Whales



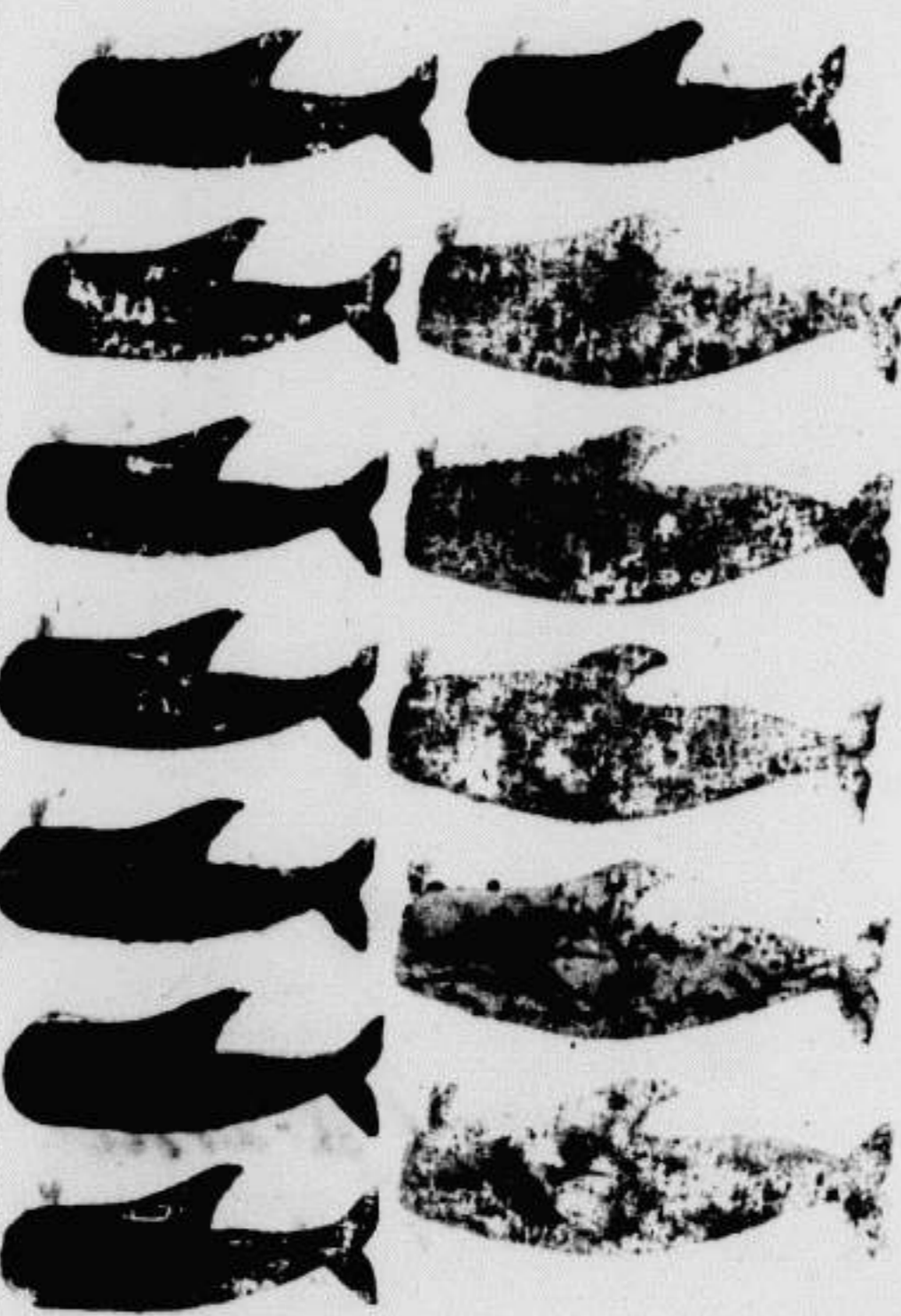
S Boat Blackfish



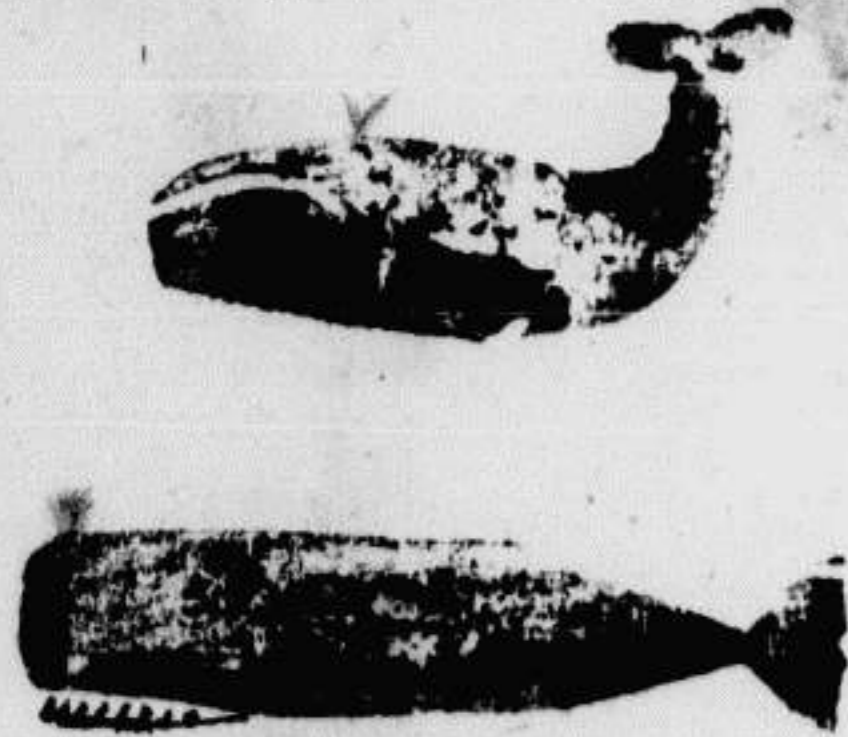
Law Boat Whales



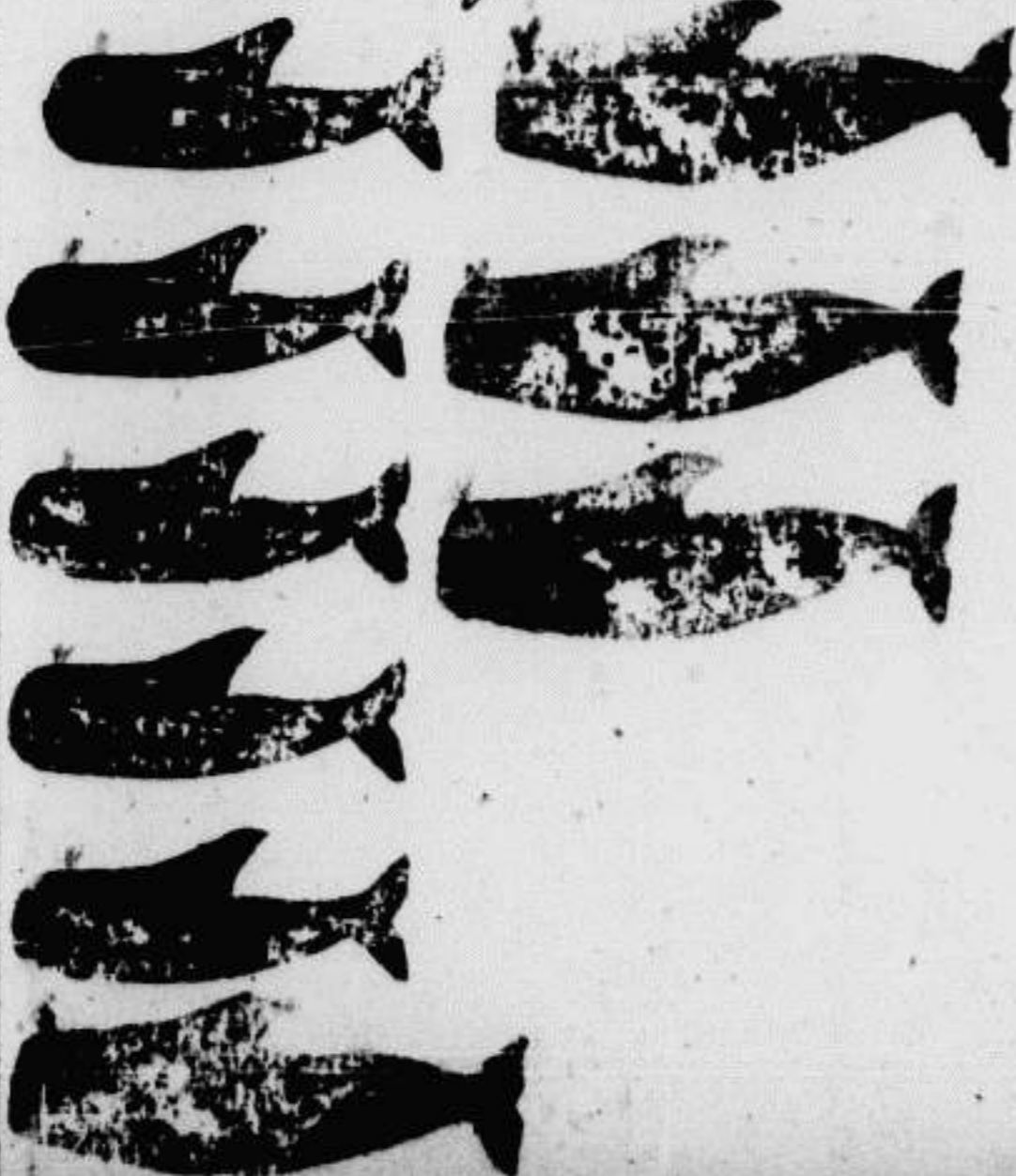

Journal of S Whaling voyage in the Brig Juno

1845

June 20th one caskety  
Melasses on Tapp

Butter one bag open

In the N and S Atlantic Ocean  
Pardon Cooks Commander  
Remarks on Board June 20th 1845  
at 1 P.M. got under way from  
parlmen island with the wind  
at S.W. beat down to starboard  
point and came to anchor  
at 5 P.M. got under way  
and went to sea down this day

Remarks on Board June 21st 1845  
this 24 hours begins with fine breeze from  
S.W. at 3 P.M. discharge pilot at 4 P.M.  
gashed bearing E.N.E. steering S.W. by W  
latter part the same all hands employed  
in fitting boats down this day dist 10 miles  
Lat 38.40 N Long 20.34 West

Remarks Thursday June 22th  
first part of this 24 hours begins with  
fine breeze from the southward all hands  
employed in fitting boats. Mid part calm  
saw plenty fishermen latter part  
calm all hands employed fitting  
boats down this day

Remarks Friday June 23th  
this 24 hours begins with light  
winds from the westward steering  
S all hands employed in ships duty  
one sail in sight latter part fresh  
breeze steering S.E. by S down this day  
Lat 38.43 N Long 19.46 West

Remarks Saturday June 24th  
this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from  
the West steering S.E. by S employed in ships  
duty. Mid part the same latter part  
steering E by S down this day Lat 36.42 N  
Long 18.03 West
