Brig Heathcote

Capt by Order of *Lt. Pettig* Second Officer of *D. H. Co.*

The Journal of a sailing voyage on board of
the *Brig Heathcote* of Newport which sailed
December the 9th for the north Atlantic Ocean
We left the anchor at one o'clock and stood to
North sea with a strong breeze from the north
west side the anchors and chains and
got all secure for the night at sundown
no Moon and bare E distance ten miles
steered south south east thru the night
so ends

Remarks on board Friday December the 10th

This day commencing with a strong breeze
from the north west at ten o'clock
began to moderate a little toward the night
out of the four topsail at one o'clock set
the main and tiller 34 50 steered S E
all these twenty four hours so ends

Remarks on board Saturday December the 11th

this day commencing with a strong breeze from
the south west and squally with a heavy rain
and fog till 11 o'clock at 12 o'clock left off
south east by south had a strong breeze thru
the night so ends

Remarks on board Sunday December the 12th

good weather and a fine breeze from the westward
saw a ship steering to the eastward under
sail latitude 34 50 longitude 68 40 we had later breeze
thru the night steered south east so ends

Remarks on board Monday December the 13th

this morning made all sail all hands at work
getting the boats ready latitude 34 50 this after
noon had it very ship breeze sent by the
wind in the forenoon had it squally thru
the night so ends
