Wednesday Sept 9th
Bark *Reeka* Asa Grinnell Master
At 10 AM took the Anchor and stood
down the bay wind NW in Co with
the Omega of Fairhaven at Noon
took the wind from S.W. Employed in
beating out of the bay at 4.30 PM the
Light boat bearing W 1/2 mile dis discharge
of the pilot at 6 PM No Norman's land
E.N.E dis 8 miles took in the top gallant
sail and steered S by E Middle and latter
fine under all sail steering S by E a
Number of sail in sight Employed in fitting
the Boats so ends this day

Friday Sept 10th this day begins
with fine weather wind S.W. steering S.E.
under all sail at sundown took in the
Light sails and furled the M. sail
Middle part fine latter the same steering
S.E. by S under all sail all hands employ-
ed in fitting Boats Lat 38.43 N Long 67.44 W

Saturday Sept 11th this day begins
with fine weather a fine breeze from
S.W. steering S.E. by S with all sail set
at sundown took in the light sails
latter part light breeze from S all hands
Employed in fitting boats Lat 38.41 N
Long 66.41 W

Sunday Sept 12th all these 24 hours
light airs from S steering to the E.S.E
under all sail two sail in sight
Lat 37.56 North
Long 66.25 West
