 Long 54.12 West

Friday Sept 28<sup>th</sup> this day begins  
 with strong gales from N.N.W  
 being two under close reefed  
 the fore sail & fore sail heading  
 N at 4 P.M. were ship to the S. of  
 middle part more moderate  
 latter light winds from N.N.W  
 made sail Lat 43.17 North  
 Long 53.38 West

Saturday Sept 29<sup>th</sup> this day begins  
 with light breezes from S. steering  
 W by N under all sail at 6 P.M.  
 thick and equally put the ship  
 under close reefed main topsail  
 & reefed fore sail middle  
 Strong gales took in the fore  
 sail latter heavy gales from W  
 took in the main topsail so ends  
 ship on the S. tack heading N  
 Lat 43.27 North  
 Long 54.07 West
