Friday May 21. First part

This day commences with light
winds from the Northward the ship
steering off after some ships for to get
the news & see ships a whaling of it
Lat 57.40 S 10 ships in sight 3 men off duty two
Tone 171.20 S. that was hurt by the whale 5th Capt
gone a gaming Middle part

Capt came on board About 9 o'clock the
ships proved to be the Cooper of
New Bedford and the Columbia of Nantucket
the Columbia had 1 whale this season

Later part
Light winds from the Northward
At 10 put off the boat for whales
No Ends

Saturday May 22 First part

Light winds At 2 o'clock the Mate
struck the second Mate the whale
rolled the boat over the third Mate
got them all right again the Mate
came up to the whale again and got burned

over again then the Mate got into the
waist boat the third Mate got the boat
all right again the waist boat then went
in to the whale and the second Mate killed
him he was a very bad acting whale
took him along side and commenced
cutting about 6 o'clock see the ship Rome
of Sydney finished cuping 10 1/2
and sat the watch for the night

Moderate breeze the ship heading
to the Northward the Capt of the Ship
Warren of Newborough came on board a
short time 2 sails in sight
Emph in mending a boat and cutting
clubs &

Sunday May 23 First part

Commences with light breeze
from the N. N. W. the ship by
Lat 58.28 the wind to the Northward and
Long in hopes soon to see bowheads
some half dozen men sick or would
like to be Middle part

The wind hailed to the E. N. E.
