

Ship Lalla Rookh on a ^{whale} voyage

- Friday June 25 Commences with a heavy gale from S.S.W. at 1 P.M. winds to set close reefed top sails Course steered E by N latter part employed in boiling blackfish large swell from S.W. Lat 41.55. N 57.55 W.
- Saturday 26 Commences with small breezes from N.W. with thick fog Course steered S. by E
- Sunday 27 Small breezes from N.W. at 5 P.M. saw a shoal of black fish caught one latter part thick and foggy Lat 41.32.57.40
- Monday 28 First part moderate breezes from S.S.W. with thick fog latter part strong breeze and rainy sun obscured
- Tuesday 29 Strong heavy winds all this day with thick fog and heavy rain at 4 P.M. saw a ship steering N.W. latter part employed in boiling out black fish sun obscured no obs.
- Wednesday 30 Strong breezes from N.W. with thick weather Course steered by compass E.S.E. Lat 57.23. Long 43.32
- Thursday 31 Strong winds from W.S.W. and thick weather Course steered E.S.E. by compass sun obs.
- Friday 30th Strong breezes from W.S.W. at 8 P.M. double reefed top sails Course steered E by S at 10 A.M. out reefs Lat 39.32. Long 37.42

From Newbedford to words Pacific ocean. 1837.

- Saturday July 1st Commences with pleasant weather fine breeze from S.W. with large swell latter part light airs and variables at noon calm Lat 39.49. N Long 35.24.15
- Sunday 2^o Strong breezes from S.W. with thick weather Course steered E.S.E. Lat 40.06 Long 32.40.15-20
- Monday 3^o quick breezes from S.W. at 6 P.M. wore ship to the S.W. by S latter part thick weather
- Tuesday 4^o Strong winds from S.E. ships head to the S.W. by S at 7 A.M. Commences breaking out the foam from water at noon thick squally weather with heavy rain sun obscured no obs. this day
- Wednesday 5^o First part thick weather middle part and latter part calm Lat 40.01.28.20
- Thursday 6^o Strong breezes from N Course steered S.W. by S Lat 38.14.
- Friday 7^o at 4 P.M. saw the Island of Fay all bearing E.N.E. dist 30 miles at 8 P.M. double reefed top sails at 8 A.M. sent one boat on shore at noon boat returned
- Saturday 8^o Moderate breezes from N. with pleasant weather at 4 P.M. took aboard a quantity of Potatoes at 8 P.M. steered out to sea Lat 37.30.25.
