

Remarks on board Wednesday February 7<sup>th</sup> 1844  
These 24 hours commences with falling winds  
and sun rain middle & later part moderate  
trails and fine weather saw five whales  
got 1-03-17

Remarks on board Thursday February 8<sup>th</sup> 1844  
These 24 hours commences with light trails  
from the S & SSW, being 4 S & S E  
at 4 Pm took in the topmast sails and  
fly 1/2 mile & later part light trails and  
fine weather got 00-44-17

Remarks on board Friday February 9<sup>th</sup> 1844  
These 24 hours commences with light trails from the  
SSE and SW with fine weather at 3 Pm  
saw the land bearing 8 distance 6 leagues  
took in topmast sails at dark middle & later  
part light trails and fine weather the water  
in logs at ships side got

Remarks on board Saturday February 10<sup>th</sup> 1844  
These 24 hours commences with light trails from  
the S and fine weather crossing of Cape Horn  
took in the light sails at dark Cape Horn  
bearing 1/2 distance 3 leagues middle & later  
part light trails and fine weather

Remarks on board Sunday February 11<sup>th</sup> 1844  
These 24 hours commences with light trails from  
the S and fine weather crossing of Cape Horn  
took in the light sails at dark and half of the  
Cape Horn middle & later part light trails and fine  
weather at day light made all sail and steam for  
Scaumbere 100 1/2 miles these 24 hours

Remarks on board Monday February 12<sup>th</sup> 1844  
These 24 hours commences with light trails from  
the S and fine weather at 3 Pm came to anchor  
in Scaumbere harbor in 12 fathoms of water  
filled the sails & at day light sent all hands  
& working and so into these 24 hours
