

Remarks On Board Bark Lancer Of New Bedford

Capt James H Fisher Master Towards Cape Horn

Tuesday Oct 30<sup>th</sup> 1877

Commenced with strong breeze and gulls from NW & drove by S Emploire getting ready to furl out a new fifth boom Middle light-booms ends Calm ended making a fifth boom with other jobs of ships duties

Wednesday Oct 31<sup>st</sup>

Commenced Calm got the fifth boom pointed out but the rigging not ready at 3 Am light breeze from W course by S Middle strong breeze and squally ends thick and rain got the fifth boom out and the rigging set up Wind W course S.S.E. No Obs

Thursday Nov 1<sup>st</sup> 1877

Commenced with fresh breeze and thick haze weather from W course S.S.E. all sail fifth boom rigged and sail set Night and latter fine weather with light breeze from W to S.W all sail course S.S.E. rigged up the fore trial mast forward to stanch mast heads with other jobs of ships duties

Friday Nov 2<sup>nd</sup>

Commenced fine from SW course S.S.E. all sail ends with fine weather but cloudy Emploire looking out and looking up things fitting fore sea putting on the shaping sea with various jobs No Obs

Saturday Nov 3<sup>rd</sup> 1877

Commenced with light breeze with cloudy weather from SW course S.S.E. all sail the watches employed on the rigging with various jobs of ships duties Middle light-booms ends Calm No Obs

Sunday Nov 4<sup>th</sup>

Commenced calm Emploire putting the rigging and cutting sea Middle light-booms from SW ends with light breeze and fine weather from SW course S.S.E. all sail

Monday Nov 5<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fine weather and light breeze from SW course S.S.E. at 4 P.M. throughout these 24 hours the same course S.S.E. Emploire repairing the fore sea sail

Tuesday Nov 6<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fine weather Emploire repairing fore sea sail and put it back S.S.E. Middle wind veering to the NE with strong breeze course S.S.E. all sail ends strong from S.W. Emploire at various jobs Lat 35.34 N Long 38.32 W

Wednesday Nov 7<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with strong breeze and cloudy from S.W. course S.S.E. all sail Middle light-booms ends with a light breeze and fine weather from S. of the wind to S.S.E. all sail Emploire at various jobs of carpentering
