Ampanan August 7th 1841

All this Day light breezes from land & calm middle fresh from South Start watch on liberty
Lark Employed in Sundry gabs
Sailed Ship *Thamilton* & *Septune*

Thursday 5th

First & later of this Day small breezes from land & calm middle fresh from South & fine Lark watch on liberty
Lark Employed in Ships Duty
Arrived *Borgue* *Bondon* Packet
Samson 150 blks & oil got off & raft water

Friday 6th

First & later small breezes from land & calm middle fresh from South
Lark watch on liberty Lark Employed in Sundry gabs of Ships Duty

Saturday 7th

All this Day fine weather first & later winds light & calm middle fresh from South Lark watch on liberty
Lark Employed in Ships Duty painted Lark boat

Sunday 8th

All this Day winds as usual weather fine Start watch on liberty Lark on board Arrived 3 whale ships

Monday 9th

All this Day winds as usual weather fine Lark watch on liberty
Lark Employed in Sundry gabs

Tuesday 10

All this Day moderate breezes & fair All hands employed in Ships Duty got off a small raft of water & got ready for moving Down to the wooding place
Junie & *Saber*

Leaving at anchor in Ampanan

Wednesday August 11

All this Day moderate breezes & fine weather weighing Deland for the want of it permit to wood All hands Employed in Sundry gabs

Thursday 12th

First part Calm & at 6 A.M. got under way with a light breeze & proceeded Down the bay to the wooding place at 11:30 Came to anchor about 8 miles from Ampanan in a snug little bay fired the sails got Dinner & started 2 boats cross Ashoor to look a place to cut wood after looking the most of the after noon found a place where we cut a part of it load & returned to the ship after sunset Discharged the boats got super & set the watch & watches for the night one of the after guard & one of the men & a sharp lookout for Drags middle & later lively breezes from South

Friday 13th

The most part of this Day fine breezes from South & fine weather All hands Employed wooding Cut & got off 5 blks

Saturday 14th

All this Day moderate breezes & fine weather All hands Employed in Ships Duty finished wooding got some sand & all ready for sea went Ashoor hunting shot 2 wilde hogs & saw a plenty

Sunday 15th

Commences calm later light & baffling breezes from North have short & hoist all sail saw the *London* packet coming Down from Ampanan so ends this Day including 12 hours at Merid nearly calm
