

Tue. Dec 16th 1902

This day quite breeze from S.E. & rainy.
At 3 P.M. crew came on board & went to the
stream & anchored. set anchor at sunset
so ende this day.

Wed. Dec 17th

This day fresh breeze from W.N.W. fine
weather. At 10 A.M. got under weigh &
took Tow boat & towed out. At 2-15 P.M.
hauled Aback. & put owners on Tow Boat
& proceeded to sea with a full gear of 81
all told. At 3 P.M. No Man's Land bore
to N.W. 4 miles from which we take our
departure steering S by E. set watch
at 7 P.M.

so ende this day.

Thur. Dec 18th

This day fresh breeze. From W.N.W.
& clear first-part latter part equally
At 8 A.M. set Top Gallant sail & kept off.
S.E. At 10 P.M. took in the Gallant sail
& hauled it.

so ende this day.

Friday Dec 19th

First-part of this day wind W.N.W.
& equally latter latter part clear. running
S.E. all day. saw two steamers toward
East. got no observation

so ende this day.

Sat. Dec 20th

First-part of this day wind W.N.W.
& equally latter part hauled to N.E.
& clear. steering S.E. to all day.
saw nothing. got no observation
started to rig boat

so ende this day.
