

Bargeed Lexington on Japan 1843

Wednesday the 23^d Moderate Easterly wind
and fine land at sail at 4 P.M. speak to
Mary Mitchell - Middle part under
short sail - Latter part under canvas
steering to the Westward two sail in
sight and a number of buoys to be
seen bearing the same

Thursday the 24th fresh easterly wind and
fine land steering to the Westward - Middle
part under short sail headed to the North
Latter part steering to the South under all sail
Latter under short sail in 27 25

Friday the 25th fresh easterly wind and fine
land steering in sight - Middle part
fine under short sail - Latter part under
all sail headed to the North the same
Latter in 27 25

Saturday the 26th Moderate Easterly wind
and light squalls of rain - except by sea
with narrow fog - steering in sight
Middle part under short sail headed to the
North - Latter part under all sail at 4 P.M.
saw a large ship thus ends

Sunday the 27th light Easterly wind
and fine - at 3 P.M. saw ship
Middle part fine under short sail
Latter under all sail steering in sight

Monday the 28th Moderate and fine
Middle part the same - Latter part
Moderate and squally - saw on sail
Employed in service for the same
steering to the East - Latter in 28 54 25
