

Bound from New Zealand to the
United States of America 1845

Sunday February 23rd fine fair strong S.W. winds
and cloudy weather. Misting by S. under single reef
and Main topgall and sail. Middle part small topgall
E.S.E. Latter part more pleasant about the reef and set
the topgall and sail thus ends Lat 49° 14' Long 100° 00' W

Monday 24th strong winds from W.W. and cloudy with
misting E.S.E. at 2 P.M. set 7 topgall and masting sail
Middle part strong squalls. Latter part more moderate
set lower and topgall and masting sail masting S.E. & E
thus ends Lat in 51° 8' Long 97° 45' W

Tuesday 25th moderate winds from the West and
foggy weather. Misting E.S.E. with all squalls sail
set at 7 P.M. strong winds from S.W. took in light sails to
crest of topgall and sail. Middle part took in topgall and
sail & reefed from Mizzen topgall. Latter strong winds and
clear thus ends Lat in 52° 58' Long 95° 07' W

Wednesday 26th strong S.W. winds and cloudy at 2 P.M.
set Main topgall and sail. Middle part strong squalls with
light rain took in topgall and sail. Latter thick and rainy
at 8 set the topgall and sail thus ends Lat 54° 00' S
Long 92° 00' W

Thursday 27th strong S.W. winds and thick weather
misting E.S.E. at 4 P.M. moderate set 7 topgall and
masting sail at 7 took it in again. Middle part moderate and
foggy set 7 topgall and masting sail. Latter moderate and fine at
dawning sail set thus ends Lat in 56° 04' S Long 88° 25' W

Friday 28th moderate winds from N.E.W. masting
all drawing sail set. Middle part winds fresh and
weather foggy. Latter much the same. Sent the 8 topgall
gallant sail on deck thus ends Lat in 57° 40' S
this day and this month and Long in 84° 35' W

Will start and shall pass the line of 25° 20' N
at 10 P.M.

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Saturday March 1st moderate winds and fresh winds
from N.W. and cloudy weather. Misting E.S.E. at 3 P.M. took
in lower and topgall and masting sail. Middle part squalls
took in light sails and reefed the Mizzen topgall
Latter strong wind and thick rainy weather. reefed
the topgall and employed a block on the foremast to
Last in 27th and Long in 78° 15' W

Sunday 2nd moderate winds from W. and foggy
weather. Misting E.S.E. set and the reef set Main
topgall and sail at 7 P.M. set masting sail. Middle
moderate winds & clear. Latter part the same
misting E.S.E. this day took in Mizzen topgall
thus ends Lat in 58° 45' S Long 75° 45' W

Monday 3rd fresh winds from N.W. and foggy
weather. Misting E.S.E. at 8 P.M. took in masting
sail. Middle part winds strong with light rain took
in light sails & reefed Mizzen topgall. Latter part much
the same at 1 P.M. took in Mizzen topgall thus ends
Lat 58° 25' S Long in 72° 30' W

Tuesday 4th strong S.W. winds and cloudy weather
misting E.S.E. Middle part the winds fresh & weather
foggy under single reef topgall. Latter part set Main topgall
& sail the weather rainy thus ends

Wednesday 5th strong weather. at 4 P.M. calm &
thick fog took in Main topgall and sail & chain sail
at 5 a breeze from S.W. at 7 a gale and thick weather took in
sails. About the 11 P.M. the wind under foremast. Middle
part more clear set Mizzen topgall and sail and kept off
E.S.E. Latter strong westerly winds and clear under sail
& Main topgall and sail thus ends Lat 58° 08' S
Long 64° 40' W
