Monday March 6th fresh easterly wind  
and clear weather. Steamer & Co. all drawing full  
set of spinnaker and wind light. Latter calm and  
foggy thus ends. Lat 57° 52' Long 72°

Tuesday 7th light air and foggy weather. Steamer  
and the anchor heavy from SSW. Steamer & Co.  
Latter wind varying thus ends. Lat 57° 12' 8"

Wednesday 8th moderate winds from SSE and  
cloudy weather. Steamer & Co. all drawing full  
middle part wind light and hazy. Latter a moderate  
gale from the SW. headed to the NW under double  
reef topails thus ends

Thursday 9th moderate gale from the NW under  
double reef topails at 2 PM worked ship to the SE  
Middle part the wind increased to 10 in 700 ft  
topails. Latter moderate and cloudy the weather  
unsteady thus ends

Monday 10th moderate breeze from SE and rainy at  
1 PM set 2 reef topails. Middle part strong  
wind from the SE and milder weather. Latter  
moderate breeze from SE under double reef  
topails thus ends. Lat 56° 24' Long 81° 12'

Tuesday 11th strong winds from NW and clear weather  
headed SE. Latter under double reef topails and  
chain sail. Middle part the same took in 100 ft  
topails. Latter fresh wind from all drawing full  
set headed SE thus ends. Lat 54° 43' Long 72°

New Zealand in 1845

Wednesday March 12th Possibilities with  
fresh NW wind and clear weather headed SE &  
under all drawing full. Middle part moderate and  
clear weather. Latter much the same at 7 PM  
set 2 reef topails. Middle part the same took in 100 ft  
at 9 PM. Latter fresh thus ends. Lat 52°  
Long 58° 2'

Thursday 13th moderate winds from S and fine  
weather. Steamer & Co. all drawing full. Middle part  
wind fresh from SW. Latter moderate and  
sail. Latter part wind light the light sails in 100 ft  
Lat 51° Long 58°

Friday 14th strong winds from SE and heavy  
under double reef topails. Middle part Latter part  
the weather thick and foggy at 7 PM set the chain sail  
thus ends. Lat 50° 44' 8"

Saturday 15th strong winds from SE and thick foggy  
weather headed SE under double reef topails  
and chain sail. Middle part Latter part the same  
thus ends

Sunday 16th moderate winds from SE and  
thick fog under whole topails and headed SE  
Middle part the same. Latter part moderate breeze  
& headed from North thus ends. Lat 49° 00' Long 58° 45'

Monday 17th moderate winds from NW and  
clear weather headed SE at 2 PM set flying jib all top  
gallardsails. Middle part fresh wind took in flying  
jib & all top gallardsails. Latter part strong winds  
and cloudy weather headed SE. Latter  
Lat 48° 00' Long 58° 22'

Tuesday 18th strong winds from SE and clear weather  
at 1 PM double reef topails. Middle part much the  
same. Latter part moderate winds and fine weather  
saw a number of timbucki thus ends. Lat 47° 19'
