Friday April 11<sup>th</sup> - 1845

Moderate wind from the East squally weather at 1 P.M. took to the sea at 7 took to the S.E. at 9 took to the N.E. at 12 took to the S.W. at 1 o'clock and later had squally and buffing weather till 5 at 7 P.M. employed on the rigging to Enos - Lat in 20.00 Long 38.50

Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> fresh winds from the East squally weather at 1 P.M. took to the S.E. at 4 o'clock an English Brig of War steering S.W. at 7 P.M. spoke an English Merchant Brig from London Bound to Rio - Middle part under way all drawing sail - later paid the winds with much the same had a vessel steering S.W. to east - Lat in 22.00 Long 38.50

Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> strong E winds and occasional squalls of rain under moderate sail headed S.E. at 4 o'clock paid fair - later paid the same to Enos - Lat in 22.45 Long 37.25

Monday 14<sup>th</sup> light winds from east and fine weather - headed S.E. under easy sail at 2 P.M. saw a vessel steering S.W. - Middle part fresh winds - later paid light and buffing winds with rain to Enos

Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> winds light and buffing with rain steering S.W. at 8 o'clock paid under S.W. wind - later the same to Enos - Lat 21.45 Long 34.40

Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> moderate buffing winds from the West and squally weather steering S.W. at 8 o'clock paid a heavy fog from South West all sail - later paid fair - saw a Brig standing to the S.W. thus Enos - Lat in 20.00 Long 34.00

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Thursday April 17<sup>th</sup> strong southerly winds with frequent squalls of rain - steering S.W. all drawing sail - later paid the same - later paid wind S.E. - paid a small Brig standing to the east thus Enos

Friday 17<sup>th</sup> strong S.E. winds and squally weather steering S.W. all drawing sail - later paid moderate and buffing - later paid much the same - saw a vessel steering to the east thus Enos - Lat in 15.00 Long 34.45

Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> light winds from east and frequent squalls of light rain at 7 P.M. spoke an English part a light brig from East and fine weather headed S.W. all drawing sail - later paid the same thus Enos - Lat in 14.00 Long 34.45

Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> moderate winds from the East and fine weather headed S.W. all drawing sail - later employed in the rigging - later paid the same - later thus Enos - Lat in 12.45 Long 34.54

Monday 21<sup>st</sup> after being from the East fine weather headed S.W. all drawing sail - at 8 P.M. saw a sail standing to the S.W. - Middle part the winds S.W. and fine - later paid the same at 7 P.M. saw a Brig steering to the S.W. thus Enos - Lat in 11.13 Long 34.00

Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> moderate winds from S.E. and fine weather headed S.W. by the winds at 2 P.M. saw a Brig standing to the S.W. employed in repairing the and darkening the lower part - Middle and - later paid under moderate, employed on various jobs thus Enos - Lat in 09.44
