Remarks on Board of Bark Lexington

Monday March the 11th - 1844
light Easterly wind and fair weather
standing to the ESE in company with the
Succorora at 5 PM the Captain came on board
and talked to the crew
Miscellaneous and Lower part much the same
to Ensign

Tuesday the 12th light Easterly wind and fair
weather standing to the ESE under all sail
Miscellaneous and Lower part much the same
Employed in making a Spanker out of a No. 10 Spinnaker
this Ensign

Wednesday the 13th light wind from the ESE
and fair weather standing to the ESE under all sail
bent the Spanker and took out for water & Beef
Miscellaneous part squally - Lower part fair
at 10 saw 2 sail
this Ensign

Thursday the 14th fresh Easterly wind and fair
weather standing to the ESE under all sail -
at 2 PM saw French Schooner and it
is 7 weeks since we left it - in each time we have
run over about 80 or 90 degrees
and carrying sail all hands and all weather
like Jack Downing when he lost his flag
but couldn't stop to pick it up because
he had an Express for the signal -
at 7 PM spoke the English Bark from
Seymour to Ensign

Friday the 15th fresh wind and fair weather
standing to the ESE at 5 PM spoke the
English Bark from Seymour
Miscellaneous part standing to the ESE
Lower part the same - Employed repairing
Slying gear making Spinnaker and other jobs
at 10 PM spoke to the ESE this Ensign
