Ship Lion on her passage to the Indies

Thursday August 28th

Bine from the North at 12 meridian weighed anchor and stood out for sea at 4 pm discharged our pilot at 7 pm Sweettail Light bore S. N. 71st dist 6 leagues from which I take my departure middle storing latter the same

Friday August 29th

Strong from the East two sails in sight middle and latter the same

Lat 47.20 Long 70.20.15



Saturday August 30th

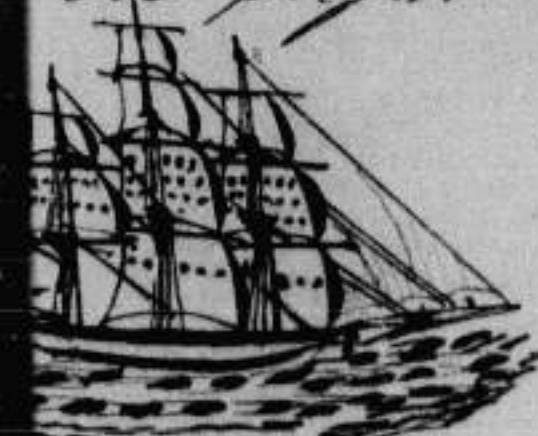
Light from the S.W. on the wind to the S by E nothing in sight middle fine latter the same

Lat 48.08 Long 69.12.00

Sunday August 31st

Light from the south on the wind to the East two sails in sight middle and latter the same

Lat 48.08 Long 68.20.45



Monday August 1st

Light from the S.W. nothing in sight middle and latter the same

Lat 47.54 Long 67.00.00
