Strong from the S.W. course E by S middle and  
latter the same. Lat 39.04 Long 32.00.50

Monday September 20th  
Strong from the S.W. at 1 pm saw the Island  
of Flores middle and latter fine.

Tuesday September 21st  
Strong from the west with squalls middle  
the same at 10 pm saw the Island of Fayal  
latter strong with rain  
Lat 38.50 Long 26.31.00

Light and pleasant laying of and on the Island  
of Fayal at 8 pm came of with our recruits at 5 put  
to sea middle fine latter the same in company  
with the schooner Alfreed of New Bedford so ended

Light from the the west course S.E. by E Dico in  
in sight middle and latter the same  
Lat 38.25 Long 28.20.50

Friday September 24th  
Light from the W. the E point of Dico bearing 7/8  
Saint George in sight course E by S. Middle and latter  
the same Lat 38.59 Long 21.12.00

Saturday September 25th  
Light from the W. N. W. nothing in sight middle  
and latter the same  
Lat 37.20 Long 20.00.15

Sunday September 26th  
Light from the W. N. W. nothing in sight middle  
and latter the same  
Lat 36.20 Long 19.04.00
