February

Tuesday 1st
9.34

Commences with fine S. E. Trades
course S. W. by E. employed in Tarring
down. A. M. broke out fore hatches
for Tar and after hole for Molasses.

Wednesday 2nd
12.42

Commences as above. course S. W. by S.
employed in Tarring down. passed
a sail steering N. set up the Mizzen
rigging and weather topmast and
Top Gallant rigging.

Thursday 3rd
14.59

commences as above course S. S. E.
employed in the Mizzen rigging
bent main Top Gallant Studding
sail and set it. A. M. set up the
head rigging. passed a sail steering
N.

Friday 4th
17.45

Commences with fine S. E. Trades
course S. S. E. Starboard watch em-
ployed in setting up fore rigging
and Starboarded the main. Ent-
ering the leeward area. commenced
sheathing the decks. A. M. employed
in the rigging. sail in sight.

Saturday 5th
19.59

commenced as above employed in
the rigging and sheathing decks
4 P. M. broke out fore hole for
Water. A. M. employed in the rigging
and sheathing decks.

Sunday 6th
22.34
37.41

Commences with light N. E. winds
course S. S. E. employed as above. middle
and later same.

Monday 7th
25.10
39.10

Commences as above. sail on the line.
A. M. employed in ships duty.

Tuesday 8th
37.48
40.17

commences as above course S. S. E.
2 sails ahead. employed in ships duty.

Wednesday 9th

Commences with fine breezes from
the N. course S. W. by S. 4 P. M. broke
out fore hole for water. middle and
later light winds with rain squalls.

Thursday 10th
31.24
42.02

commences with strong breezes from
S. E. P. M. took in light sails and
double reefed topsails. Jib and spanker.
A. M. set main Top gallant sail.

Friday 11th
33.30

commences with fine breezes from
S. S. E. all sail set. A. M. wind N. N. E.
course S. W. by S. bent main Top Gallant
Studding sail.

Saturday 12th
34.42
46.34

commences with fine breezes from
N. N. E. course S. W. by S. 4 P. M. broke out
after hole for beef. A. M. wind S. E.
6 A. M. laying to. close reefed main
Top sail and Fore sail.

Sunday 13th
35.15
47.52

commences with strong winds from the
double reefed Top sail. Jib. Main sail.
9 P. M. made all sail.
