July 2nd moderate trades the boat in fair trading
and at 4 P.M. came on board and kept off by a
katter light air saw a brig standing to the S.W.
Lat. by obs. 15. 54. 8 Long by acc. 24. 10. 0

Tues. July 3rd Light trades from S.W. morning
Ship & all sail on latter pleasant weather
Long by obs. 16. 10. 8 Long by acc. 25. 0. 0

Wed. July 4th moderate trades and fine weather
with all sail on latter saw black birds
Lat. in 16. 48. 8 Long in 26. 20. 0

Thurs. July 5th light winds and variable latter
at 4 P.M. heavy rains and thick at 8 clear with
a light breeze from S.W. &c.
Lat. by obs. 17. 05. 8 Long in 26. 15. 0

Fri. July 6th light breezes & calms and heavy
squalls of rain all sail on working
South wind veering to all points of the compass
latter wind from West S.W. &c.
Lat. in 18. 43. 8 Long in 26. 50. 0

Sat. July 7th moderate breezes from the South
& S.W. & squally on a wind to the S.W. latter
calm & squally saw a merchant ship at 10 saw
a sail to the Westward no lat. Long 21. 20. 0

Sun. July 8th light air from the South North
steering S by E at 8 P.M. light breezes from S.W. &c.
latter light air from S.W. set the steering sails
No lat. this day by acc. 28. 00. 0 Long 21. 00. 0

Mon. July 9th light air and clear wind from
West squally latter squally with heavy
rains and moderate breezes from S.W. &c.
No. alt. this day by lat. in 9. 8 Long 21. 00. 0

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Tues. July 10th light breezes & calm as usual
1. sail in sight &c.
Lat. by obs. 17. 43. 8 Long by acc. 21. 00. 0

Wed. July 11th rainy at 4 P.M. took a squall from
the S.W. took in light sails at 4 P.M. made in port
made all sail up with latter light winds
from the S.W. heading South S.W. & sails
No. alt. by obs. 17. 01. 8 Long by Chron. 19. 30. 30 West

Thurs. July 12th light winds and barbers as
usual latter moderate breeze from S.W. at 8
P.M. tacked to the S.W. wind & two sail in sight
Lat. by obs. 16. 46. 8 Long by Chron. 19. 22. 00 West

Fri. July 13th light winds and play heading
S.W. at 5 P.M. spoke the California of Boston
5. 2 days out at 9 tacked to the S.W. wind & S.W. latter
made at breeze and squally heading S.W. & S.W. two
ships in sight to the S.W. &c.
No. alt. this day by acc. 18. 50. 8 Long in 19. 00. 0

Sat. July 14th smart breezes from the South
standing to the West at 5 tacked to the S.W. & at
9 tacked to the Westward latter smart breezes at 10 P.M.
tacked to the S.W. saw two ships to the
S.W. &c.
Lat. by obs. 18. 5. 8 Long by obs. Chron. 19. 49. 30 West

Sun. July 15th smart breezes from South standing
to the S.W. &c. saw 3 ships at 4 P.M. tacked to the
West by S latter 2 ships & 1 brig in sight
S.W. heading W.S.W. &c.
Lat. by obs. 18. 56. 8 Long by obs. at 4 P.M. 18. 36. 00 West

Mon. July 16th smart breezes standing to the S.W. & all
sail on with the California latter wind S.W. at 10
tacked to the S.W. Lat. in 18. 46. 8 Long by obs. 20. 50. 50
