flour. Oct 4<sup>th</sup> Nothing. Oct 5<sup>th</sup> Nothing gains. Oct 6<sup>th</sup> Making spungy am  
Landed the Bark Boies six months 70 lbs. Oct 7<sup>th</sup> Saw black fish  
but did not know. Oct 8<sup>th</sup> Nothing. Oct 9<sup>th</sup> Making season stuff.  
Oct 10<sup>th</sup> Breaking out flour. Oct 11<sup>th</sup> Made flour about 2 o'clock  
didn't stop. Oct 12<sup>th</sup> Raining. Oct 13<sup>th</sup> Making a spritsail yard  
and land about 15 miles off. Oct 14<sup>th</sup> Arrived in Fayal early in  
the morning got 1 letter from Mother, one from Helena, one from
