At 9 Am came on board with the pilot and at 12 past 9 weighed anchor and stood out for sea with fresh breezes and squally weather employed on getting the anchors on the bar so ends this day

Fresh breezes and cloudy weather At 12 past 3 Pm left the pilot the light boat bearing South At 4 Pm set the watch Gay Head light bearing N E the middle part moderate breezes from S W the latter part without the changes and stored them below all the latter part light and pleasant breezes one sail in sight to the Eastward

Lat 40° 46' North

Remarks on board Ship *Majestic* July 27th

Comes in with light breezes from S W on the wind on the Starboard tack with topgallant sails set steering per compass S by E The middle part fresh breezes from W S W the latter part much the same all hands employed on fitting the boats

Lat 39° 52' North Long 2 Pm 70° 38' West
