

Remarks On Board Of Ship

When we go in again if he is no better we shall have to leave him and proceed on with our voyage.

Monday Sept 19th 1839. Commences with light breezes steering by the wind to the Eastward. Middle part light breeze at daylight. Saw the Isles of Pico and Fayal bearing East. Latter part calm. Watcher Employed in various jobs. So Ends

Tuesday Sept 20th Continues Calm. Middle part light air. Latter part gentle breezes from the Westward steering East at 9 AM. Saw Blackfish lowered for them and took four two to L. B. and one to the Waist and Bow Boats. a Brig in sight. Pico and Fayal. So Ends

Wednesday Sept 21st First part light breezes Employed in cutting up the blackfish &c. Middle part Lying aback. Latter part kept off East for Fayal at 6 AM the boat went on shore for the Capt. at midday the Capt came on board quite well. and I am rejoiced to think he is well and we are to leave these Islands. steering S. E.

Thursday Sept 22nd Moderate breezes the first part of this day from the N. N. W. steering S. E. employed in boiling Blackfish at 4 O. C. finished. at day light saw the Island of St. Michaels and steered for it at 10 AM the boat went on shore. Lying off and on the rest of this day

Friday Sept 23rd At 4 P.M. the boat returned from the shore with Potatoes. Eggs. Oranges &c and kept off S. E. Middle part steering East Latter part strong breezes and squally steering to the South. So Ends

Wednesday October 5th 1839. Commences with fine weather and moderate breezes steering S. W. by E. Middle and Latter part fine weather and light breezes steering S. W. Cooper employed in working over old Spies Shocks. Watcher Viciously Employed. Lat by Obs 16.01 N. Long by Obs 23. 33 W.

Thursday Oct 6th Light breezes and fine weather steering S. W. by E. Middle part Lying aback. Latter part light breezes. daylight saw the Island of St. Jago and kept up for it. So Ends. Lat by Obs 15.01 N. Long by Obs 23. 53 W

Friday Oct 7th First part light air and calm saw Blackfish lowered and took one. at 6 P.M. saw the Island of Fogo. Middle and Latter part light breezes working up to port Praya Ends the same

Saturday Oct 8th At 2 P.M. the boat went on shore at 6 returned with 10 Pigs 6 Turkeys & Oranges. Several Vessels Lying at anchor one American. Schoop of War. at 7 P.M. steering S. E. W. Middle and Latter part moderate steering S. E. W. Employed in boiling Blackfish & Sunday 9th Lat by Obs 13. 26 N. Long 24. 15 W

Sunday Oct 9th Continues moderate trades steering S. E. W. Middle part the same Latter part fresh breezes and squally with rain showers. steering various ways. So Ends on the 29 of Sept. the Cook filled up one bbl of Flusk and we have started 15 bbls of Beef and pork up to this date 2 bbls of Bread 4 bbls of Flour 2 Hogs of Butter &c. Lat by Obs 11. 16 N. Long by Obs 23. 45 W
