

Bound to the trustees

Saturday August 12th 1835

Commenced with strong breezes from E. course by the hands employed in ships duty. At 1 pm sails set. Steaming to the W. all the middle and latter parts the same. Broke out for fish and better to eat. Lat 24° 35' N Long 24° 40' West

Sunday August 13th 1835

This 24 hours commenced with strong trades course. By the hands employed in ships duty all the middle and latter parts fine weather to ends. This 24 hours Lat 22° 45' N Long 24° 10' West

Monday August 14th 1835

Commenced with gentle trades and cloudy weather. Breezes from E. running with all sail set all the middle and latter parts fine weather. In ships duty. To ends this 24 hours Lat 25° 47' N Longitude 25° 3' West

Tuesday August 15th 1835

This 24 hours commenced with gentle trades and fine weather. Breezes from E. running with all sail set. In ships duty. At 8 am broke out and got up. Datter and bread to ends this 24 hours. Latitude 18° 35' N Longitude 24° 51' West

Wednesday September 1st 1835

This 24 hours commenced with brisk trades course. By the hands employed with all sail set. ran to the westward of us. At 2 pm we were out of sight. Middle part made cautious steering by E. Distance 6 leagues. Latter part saw 2 ships one of whale ship the other a merchant man. Latter parts strong breezes from E. steer E. and W. This 24 hours Lat 16° 47' N Long 24° 69' West

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Saturday 12th 1835

Commenced with gentle breezes from West. With small rain course. Employed in ships duty. All the middle and latter parts equally and rainy to ends this 24 hours Lat 24° 30' N Long 24° 30' West

Sunday 13th 1835

Equally equally weather and light winds from West. Sweeter with plenty of rain. All the latter part the same. Broke out for fish and better to eat. Lat 20° 57' N Long 20° 57' West

Monday 14th 1835

Commenced with strong winds from West. Steer to appear star tack under sail. This 24 hours all the middle and latter parts fine weather. Broke out for fish and better to eat. The same broke out the after hole. In ships duty. At 8 am broke out and got up. Datter and bread to ends this 24 hours. Longitude 24° 10' West

Tuesday 15th 1835

Commenced with gentle breezes from West. Steer to appear the star tack under sail. In ships duty. At 8 am broke out and got up. Datter and bread to ends this 24 hours. Latitude 18° 35' N Longitude 24° 51' West

Wednesday 16th 1835
