This day comes with strong easterly wind Middle part laying under two by sail and fore by sail Latter part raised a school of Bull whale going into N.E. toward for them and the Mate struck and got store and mate took the whale and at 10 o'clock got the whale alongside got up cutting gear and at this day ends cutting

This day comes with crew employed cutting in at 11.30 o'clock finish cutting Middle part started the work Whales wind porpoise around the vessel during the night Latter part finish loading hauled up about 15-00

This day comes with westerly winds crew employed clearing up deck Weather very hazy Middle and Latter part the same with wind from S.W.

Saturday May 13thLat 37-30

This day comes with pleasant weather and good breeze from S.W. but still very hazy saw plenty of porpoise got two also saw several porpoise Middle & latter part thick fog no mast heads up to day

Sunday May 14th Lat 37-33
Long 73-05

This day comes with thick fog no mast heads up at dark clearing some but still very foggy Middle & latter part good breeze from S.E. Spoke side Brozer she having seen whales figure

Monday May 15th Lat 36-56
Long 73-18

This day comes with fresh Easterly wind and hazy weather Middle part the same latter part three whales in sight two of them striking Ende with calm and thick fog

Tuesday May 16th No Obs.

This day comes with calm and thick fog Middle part good breeze from S.W. but still hazy Latter part three whales in sight striking and cutting in.

Wednesday May 17th Lat 36-25
Long 73-15

This day comes with pleasant weather but still very hazy Spoke side Ellen A. Swift two weeks out with about 80 lbs of oil Middle and latter part very foggy with wind S.W. saw plenty of porpoise.
