Friday Oct 18th 1844

These 24 hours began with moderate winds from the
NW with pleasant weather Ship standing SE by E
with sail set up to main top gallant sail &
the Watch employed in doing Ships duty Middle part
had some squalls of rain Latter part had fresh breezes
from the W & fair land men at the anchor head looking
out for Whales Ends the same

at Noon Lat by Obs 33.33 N
Long by Obs 57.09 W

Saturday Oct 20th

These 24 hours began with fresh breezes from the
West with fair weather the Watch employed in doing
Ships duty at 11 1/2 set the Foretop Gallant sail
& main top Middle part wind veered to the NW
at evening SE Latter part wind set all sail
Ends with strong winds Peter was sick & off duty
