Sunday Nov 25

Begins with brisk trades from the NE at 10 AM I came on Board and we Stood out from Honolulu in order to feet to windward of the Island Middle part brisk trades fact to the south later part found it hard being beat of West run down to leeward of the Island

Monday Nov 26

Begins with brisk trades at 3 PM hold up 10 AM at 5 AM next day Wharf Ship heading NW at 6 took in Top Gails Main Top & Sail at eight Wakes Baring North list 15 Miles Middle part Strong trades took in Top & Gails Next later part rather more moderate Got the Main Top & Sail the Watch employed in Ships Duty

Begins with brisk breezes from East Ship heading NE & the Watch employed in fitting Boats and other things Middle part brisk trades later part much the same employed in repairing Stambord Boat and drawing yards for Springing

Begins with fine weather Winds from the East Ship heading NE & the Watch employed Middle part brisk trades from the East and ESE all Sail out Ship heading from NE to NE by E

Begins light breezes and Squally Some rain at 3 PM Ship came up & kept her East Winds SSE the Watch employed Middle part Strong breezes from the SSE Ship heading ENE took in Top & Sail the Watch employed

Begins Strong breezes Squally took in Main Top & Sail Split over Gail and tore it Bad Bent it in bent Another Middle part Strong breezes from the SE Ship heading to the E by S

Remarks on Saturday Nov 1

Begins with brisk breeze from the South and E Ship heading to the E by E on a Wind all Sail out the Watch employed in Ships Duty

Sunday Dec 2

Begins with moderate breezes from the SE heading ENE all Sail out at 1 PM on bent the Gail and bent the Old one Middle part Brisk breezes from the SSE Strong E by S at 5 o'clock Got the four Top Steaming Sail

Monday December 4

Begins with fine weather Winds from the SSE Steaming E by North all Sail out at night Got the Main Top and Middle part Brisk breezes from the South and SSE all Sail out hoars E by North
