

Wednesday June 13<sup>th</sup> 1865

Journal of a Whaling voyage on board of the  
Barque <sup>of</sup> Henrietta January 1854 <sup>commanded by</sup> Capt Long

Thurs 1<sup>st</sup> This day comm with a fine breeze  
from S E & pleasant weather SSWSE 2843  
steering SSW Employed  
Repairing sails & Enots

Fri 2<sup>o</sup> Moderate breeze from S E SSWSE  
steering SSW at 5 P M saw  
Sunday Island at sundown  
shortened sail at day light  
made sail one sail in sight  
Employed Repairing Sails

Sat 3<sup>o</sup> Light breeze from E <sup>swallow</sup>  
Island in sight at 11 A M sails  
2 sails in sight  
a school of sperm Whales  
lowered four boats without success  
30:16 178-82

Sun 4<sup>o</sup> Light breeze all four boats  
Chasing Whales till sundown &  
left them at 5 P M saw some  
more lowered with the ship  
Same lanes boats & chased  
them without success ends

Mon 5<sup>o</sup> Light air & calm one sail in  
sight the Watch Employed Repairing  
the main sail

Tues 6<sup>o</sup> Light breeze from northward  
one sail in sight caught some  
Ship Jacks

Wednes 7<sup>o</sup> Light variable winds on various  
tacks at sundown shortened sail  
at day light made sail four sails  
in sight named by the ship William C. King  
of New Bedford Sunday Island in
