Wednesday August 29 (1877)

This day begins with squally weather and
squalls. Saw two sails at sundown.
Strong winds from S on the starboard
tack middle part the same at daylight
and latter part squally weather. Two sails
in sight Lat 36:15 N Lon 48:20 W

Thursday 30th 66

This day begins with light and variable
winds. Two sails in sight at break
out for Beans and Rice at sun
down three sails in sight moderate
winds from SW Steering S.E.
middle part fine winds from SW
continued steering S.E. at day light and
latter part all hands employed discharging
up Reggin Lat 35:50 N Lon 45:40 W

Friday 31st

This day begins with pleasant breeze from
W.W. during the ev all hands employed
in scuttling up Reggin. Saw one sail at
sun down. Pleasant breeze from W.W.
continued middle part fine weather
at day light and latter part the same
one sail in sight employed in scuttling
up Reggin Lat 34:55 N Lon 45:00

Saturday September 1st

This day begins with pleasant breeze
from W.W. steering S.E. watch employed
in scuttling up Reggin. Saw a Breach
at sun down the same. Continued
middle part fine weather at day light and
latter part the same watch employed in the ship's
duties Lat 34:14 N Lon 44:14 W
