let go and we made ^{the port} steering S. by E. 1/2 E. 20 ends

Tuesday 3rd

Commenced with a fine breeze from W with fog B^o
steering S. by E. middle part the same B^o steering
S. by E. latter part a light breeze from N. B^o steering
S. by E. hands employed in stowing anchors and
getting boats ready to sea.

Wednesday Dec 1st

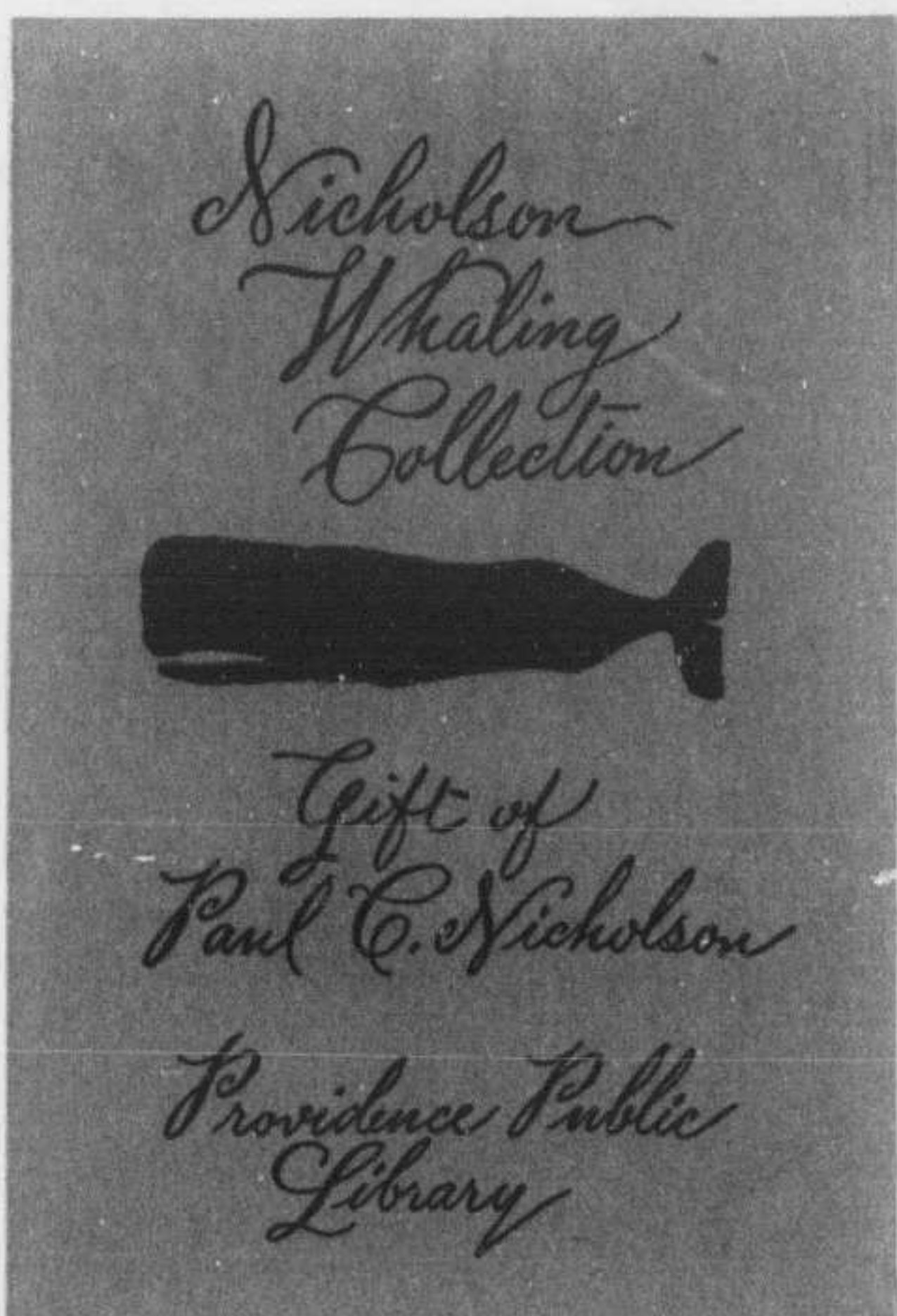
Commenced with a fine breeze from N. B^o steering S. by E.
