Monday Oct the 6

This day commences with fine weather fair  
Wind from the WSW saw a Sail bound  
to the Westward at Sundown strong breeze  
from the SW Middle part the same  
attended with rain squalls single reefed  
the Topsails later part made all sail  
with the Wind still to the SW  
thus ends the 13 day

Sat 36 12 N Long 48 35 W Course SE by E

Tuesday Oct the 7

This day commences with a fine breeze from  
the SW all Sail out Sundown the same  
this evening pump Ship and had one hour  
pumping Middle the same later part  
Saw a Sail standing to the Southward  
the Wind to the Westward  
thus ends the 14 day and 2 Weeks

Sat 35 06 N Long 46 02 W Course SE

Wednesday Oct the 8

This day commences with a fine breeze  
from the NW all Sail out lashed the  
Shackels for the cutting pendants to the  
Mast must haul at Sundown the Wind  
to the North got some further observation  
this afternoon Middle part fine breeze  
further part light from the North  
hands employed at their several  
duties
